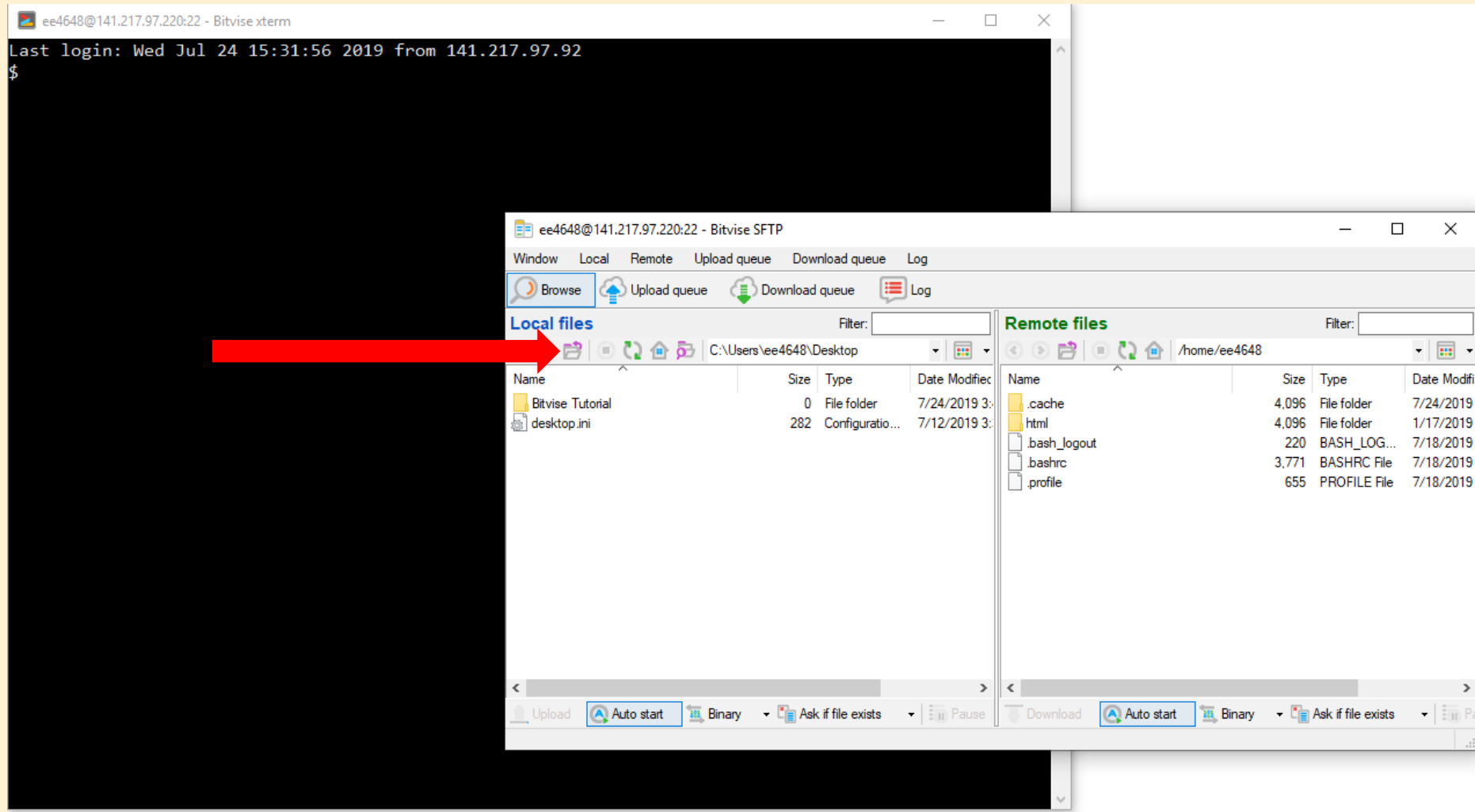


How to Upload Files to Bitvise

1. Click on the “Up” icon



2. Find the folder that your file is in and open the folder

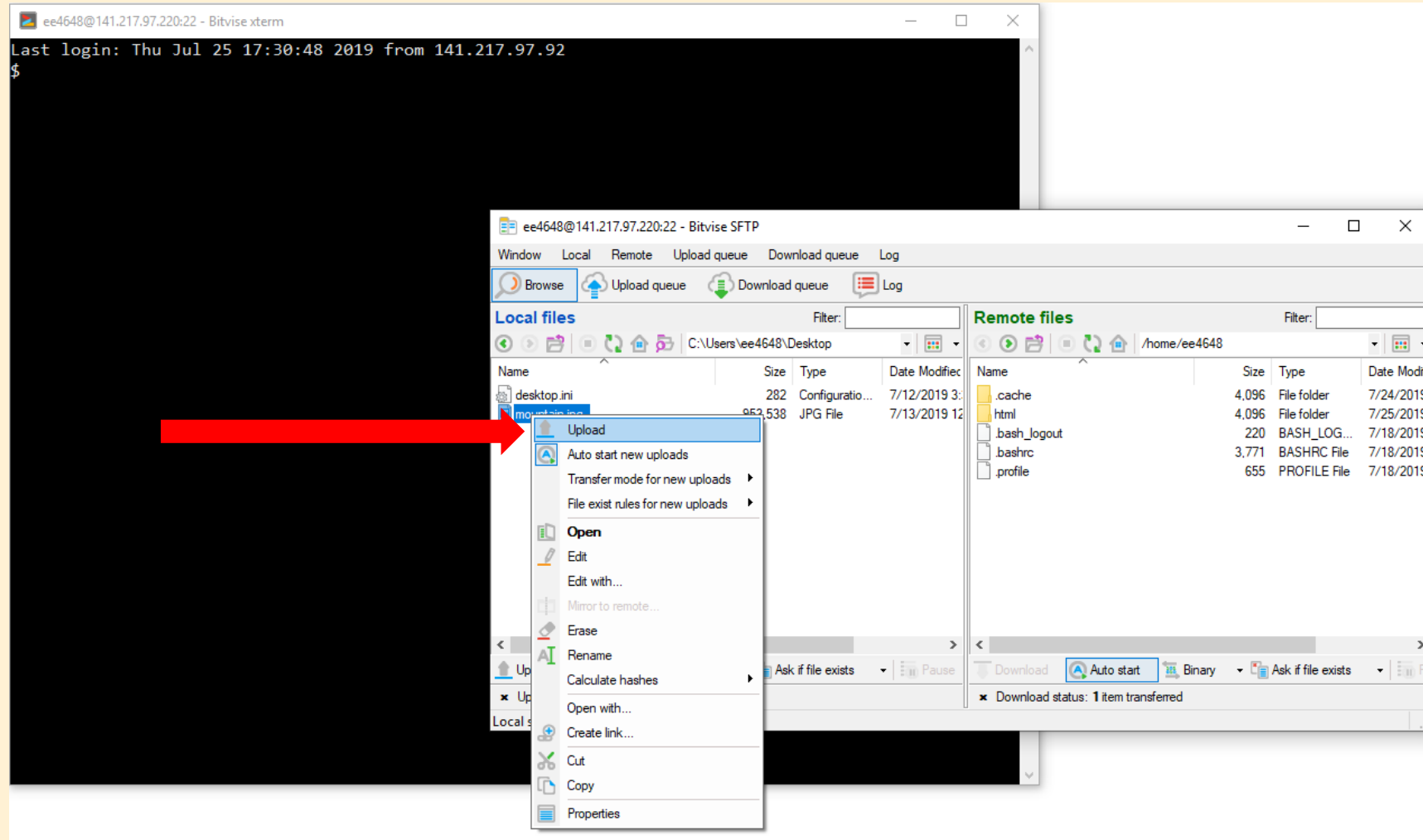
