2. Once PuTTY is downloaded, open the program and configure the settings like below. Click "Open" when finished.

3. A window will open with a command prompt. Enter your Wayne Access ID and press "Enter" on your keyboard.





4. The server will then prompt you to enter your password given to you in your Wayne email. Type it in and press "Enter" on your keyboard. Note: The password will not show up as you are typing for security purposes.
