

Student Scholarship Descriptions

Isabel James Bath Endowed Scholarship (477156)

The award recognizes scholastic achievement and provides assistance to students who plan to pursue careers as school, public or academic librarians in the metropolitan Detroit area.

Rosemary Benedetti Endowed Scholarship (477761)

This scholarship fund was established to recognize scholastic achievement and assist students pursuing a career in school librarianship.

Sallie Ellison Memorial Endowed Scholarship (447504)

This award encourages continued academic progress and provides assistance to students who reflect Ms. Ellison's dedication to inner city, urban, minority communities and to quality library service.

Judith J. Field Endowed Scholarship (447621)

This award is designed to support a student who has demonstrated a penchant for innovation, creativity, and "out of the box" thinking during his/her career to date.

Gloria A. Francis Memorial Endowed Scholarship (447057)

Preference is given to students with a special interest and expertise in the areas of rare books and archives.

Margaret Hayes Grazier Endowed Scholarship (447555)

Supports students who demonstrate an interest in school library media or youth services.

Robert P. Holley Endowed Scholarship (447458)

Recipients are selected on the basis of high scholastic achievement and desirable qualities of character and leadership.

Miriam T. Larson Memorial Endowed Scholarship (447012)

This award supports students who demonstrate a commitment to the health sciences and/or medical libraries profession.

Library and Information Science Alumni Scholarship (447965)

This award supports a student who has completed at least six (6) credit hours and possesses a grade point average of 3.6 or higher.

Margery A. Long Endowed Scholarship for Archival Administration (061904)

The award recognizes scholastic achievement and provides assistance to students in the archival administration graduate certificate program.

Joseph J. Mika and Maranne Hartzell-Mika Endowed Scholarship (447848)

This scholarship was established by long-time SLIS Professor and former Director Joseph Mika and his wife, Marianne Hartzell-Mika, to recognize high scholastic achievement and to assist students currently working in a library.

Roger S. and Muriel A. Pepper Endowed Scholarship (477066)

This award recognizes scholastic achievement and provides financial assistant to full-time or part-time graduate or undergraduate students enrolled in or accepted for study in the School of Library and Information Science.

Edith B. Phillips Endowed Scholarship (447112)

This award provides financial support for a student demonstrating an interest in technical services.

Diane M. Rockall Scholarship (444789)

The recipient of this award may be any graduate student enrolled in the School of Library and Information Science who demonstrates scholastic achievement (minimum grade point average of 3.5) and financial need.

Clara Lulis Russell Memorial Scholarship (447718)

Preference for this award is given to students who exemplify a capacity to overcome life obstacles similar to Mrs. Russell's. They must be enrolled in the School of Library and Information Science and pursuing public librarianship.

Charles Samarjian Memorial Scholarship (447160)

Created for students enrolled in or admitted into the School of Library and Information Science with a career interest in antiquarian/rare book librarianship.

Robert L. Sherwood Scholarship (445050)

Recipients of this award are enrolled in the School of Library and Information Science with a specialization in public librarianship. Preference will be given to students with a demonstrated interest in serving the Herrick District Library or Ottawa and Allegan Counties.

Lothar Spang Memorial Scholarship (477122)

The award is designed to support 36 credits of graduate credit for a student with extreme financial need who demonstrates career plans to serve as a public librarian or school media specialist in an underserved, urban community in the Detroit metropolitan area.

Peter and Jane Spyers-Duran Endowed Scholarship (447106)

Any graduate student enrolled in the School of Library and Information Science who demonstrate ongoing scholastic achievement with a grade point average of at least 3.0 and qualities of character and leadership.

Cymbrie Pratt Trepczynski Endowed Scholarship for Archival Administration (060318)

The award recognizes scholastic achievement and provides assistance to students in the archival administration graduate certificate program.

Carolyn R. Williams Endowed Scholarship (447341)

Preference is given to applicants from disadvantaged, underserved, urban communities.

H. W. Wilson Scholarship (441081)

Recipients are selected on the basis of scholastic achievement and qualities of character and leadership.
