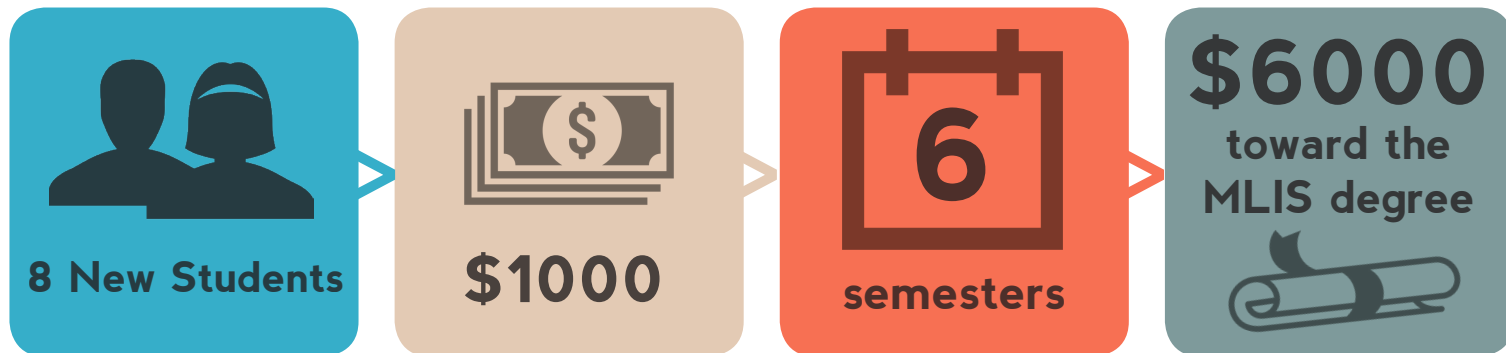


Ready for a library leadership role?

Create a new future with Wayne State's Workforce Development Scholarship



The School of Library and Information Science has partnered with the Detroit Area Library Network (DALNET) and the Suburban Library Cooperative (SLC), to offer eight \$6,000 scholarships to paraprofessional employees of libraries within the cooperatives who are interested in pursuing their MLIS degrees starting Fall 2015.

19 institutions

62 distinct libraries/branches



21 public libraries
Suburban Library Cooperative

These scholarships will give each recipient \$1000 tuition remission per semester, over six semesters, while pursuing the 36-credit MLIS.

Requirements to receive the scholarship include:

- employed by one of the participant library cooperative agencies
- undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or higher
- two years of relevant work experience
- admission to the WSU-SLIS MLIS program
- two letters of recommendation
