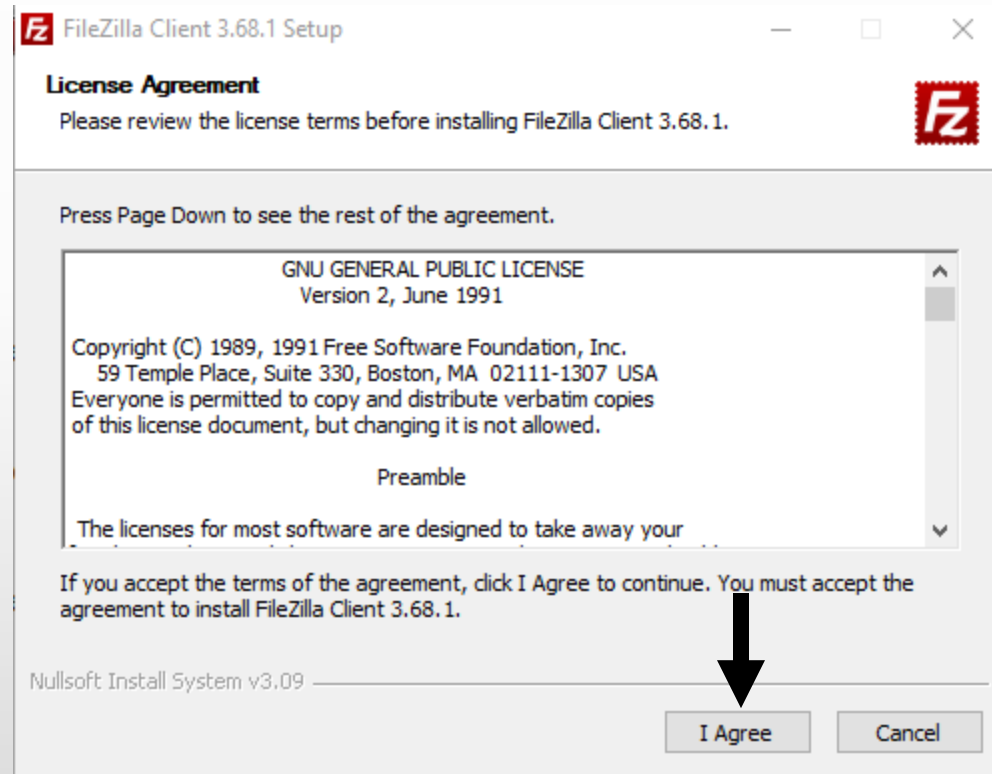
5) Wait for the download to complete.
Then click on it to begin installation.



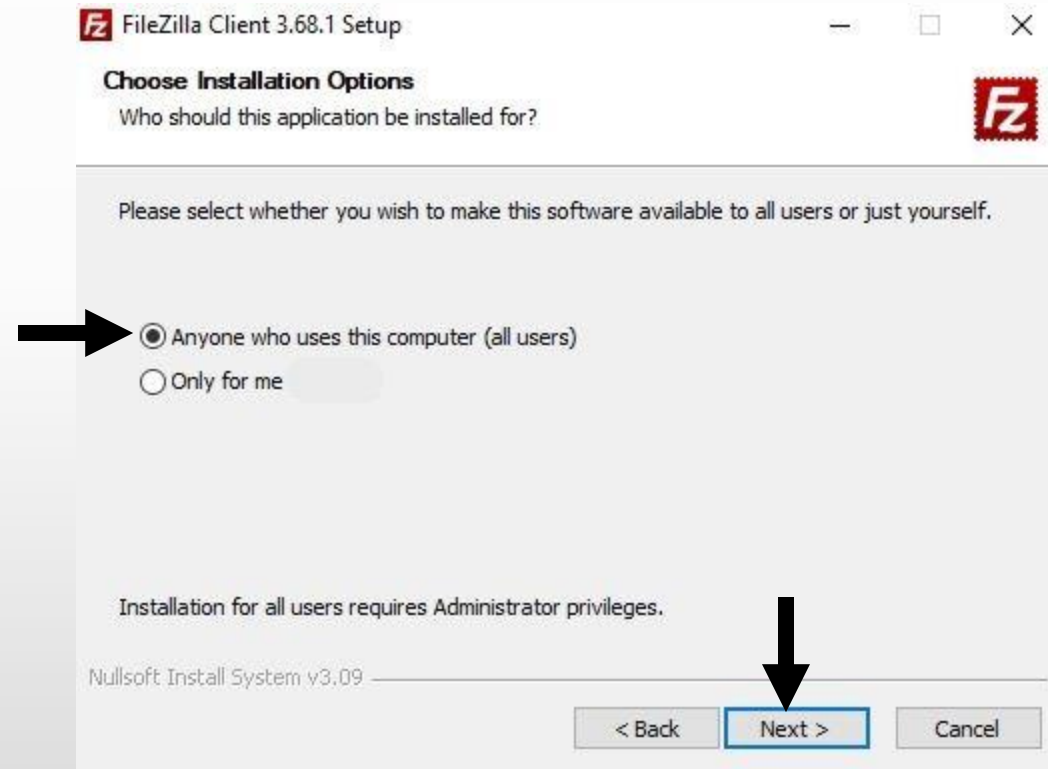
6) When this window appears, click **Yes**.



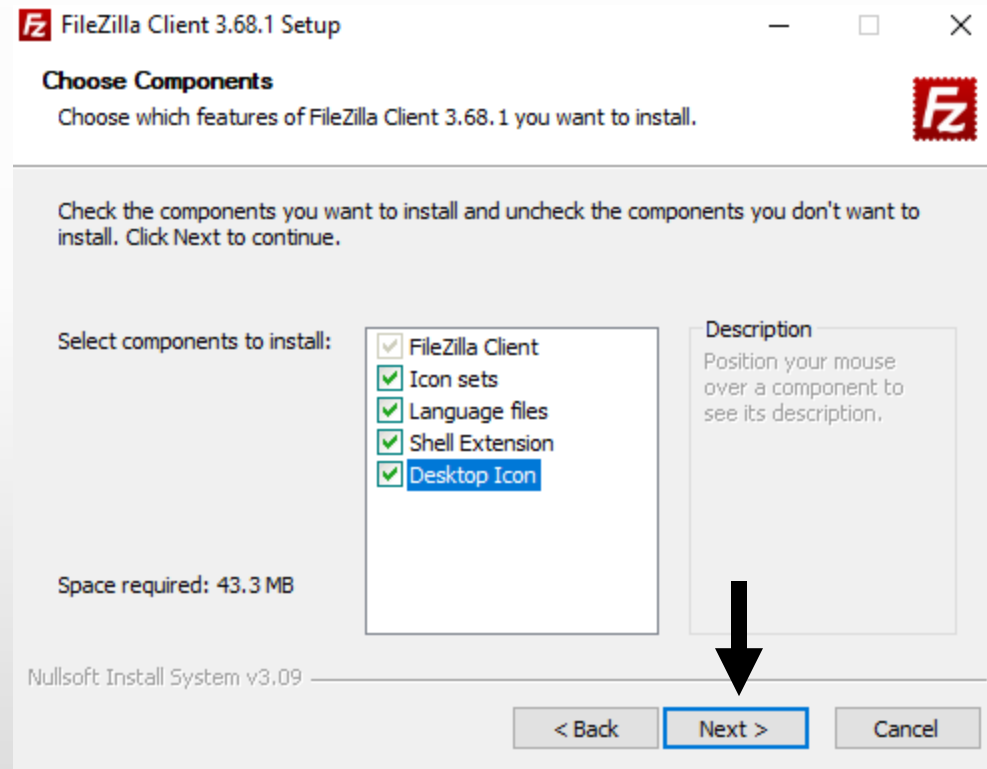
7) When this window appears, click **I agree**.



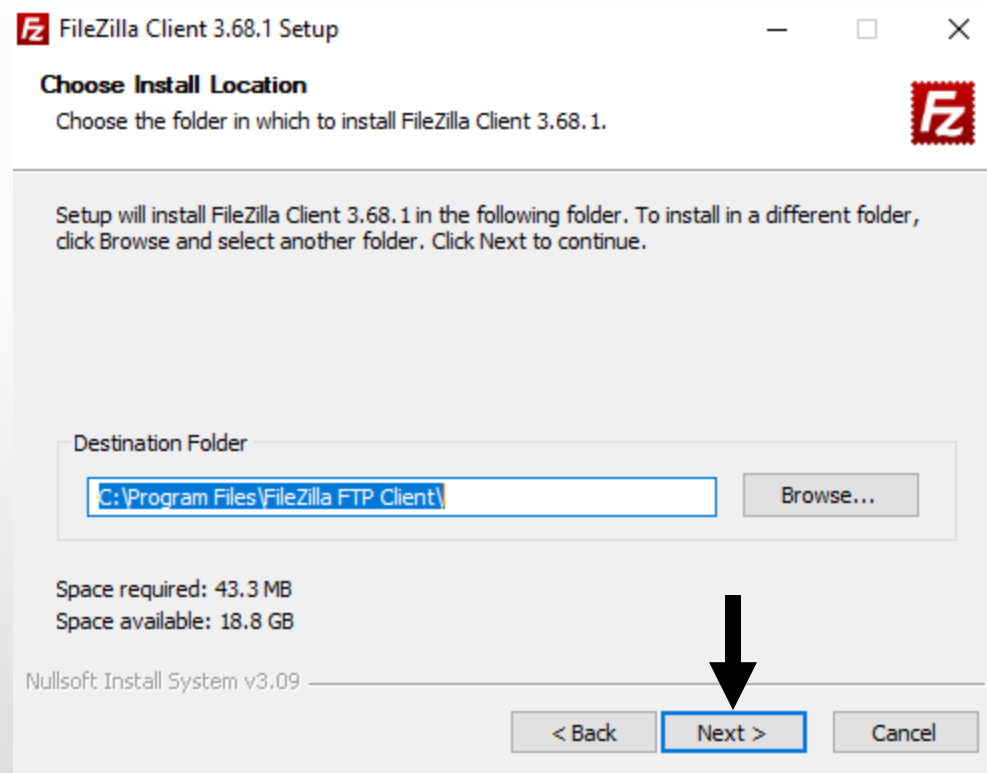
8) Choose **Anyone who uses this computer (all users)**. Then click **Next >**.



9) Check all the boxes. Then click **Next >**

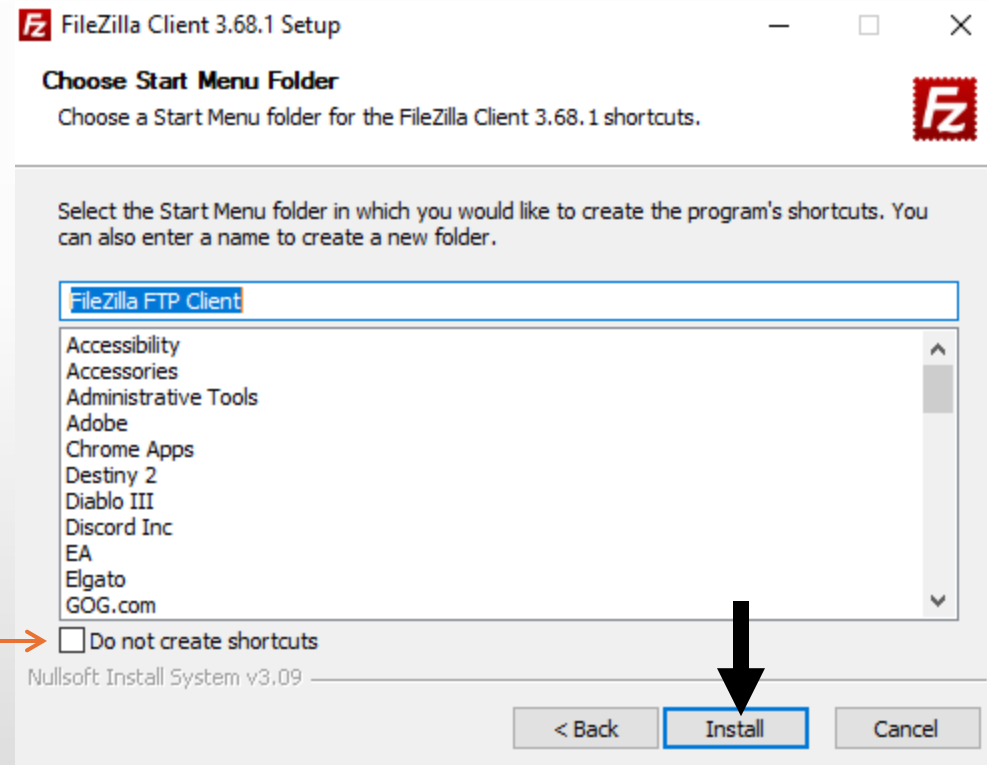


10) Use default destination. Click **Next >**

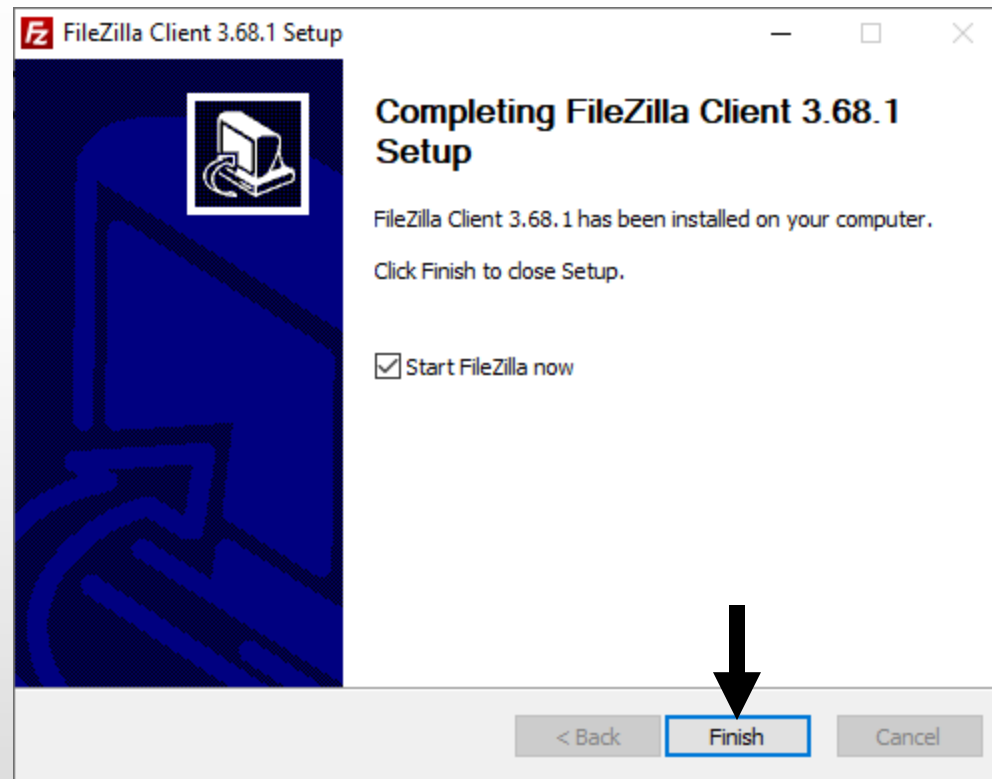


11) Click **Install**.

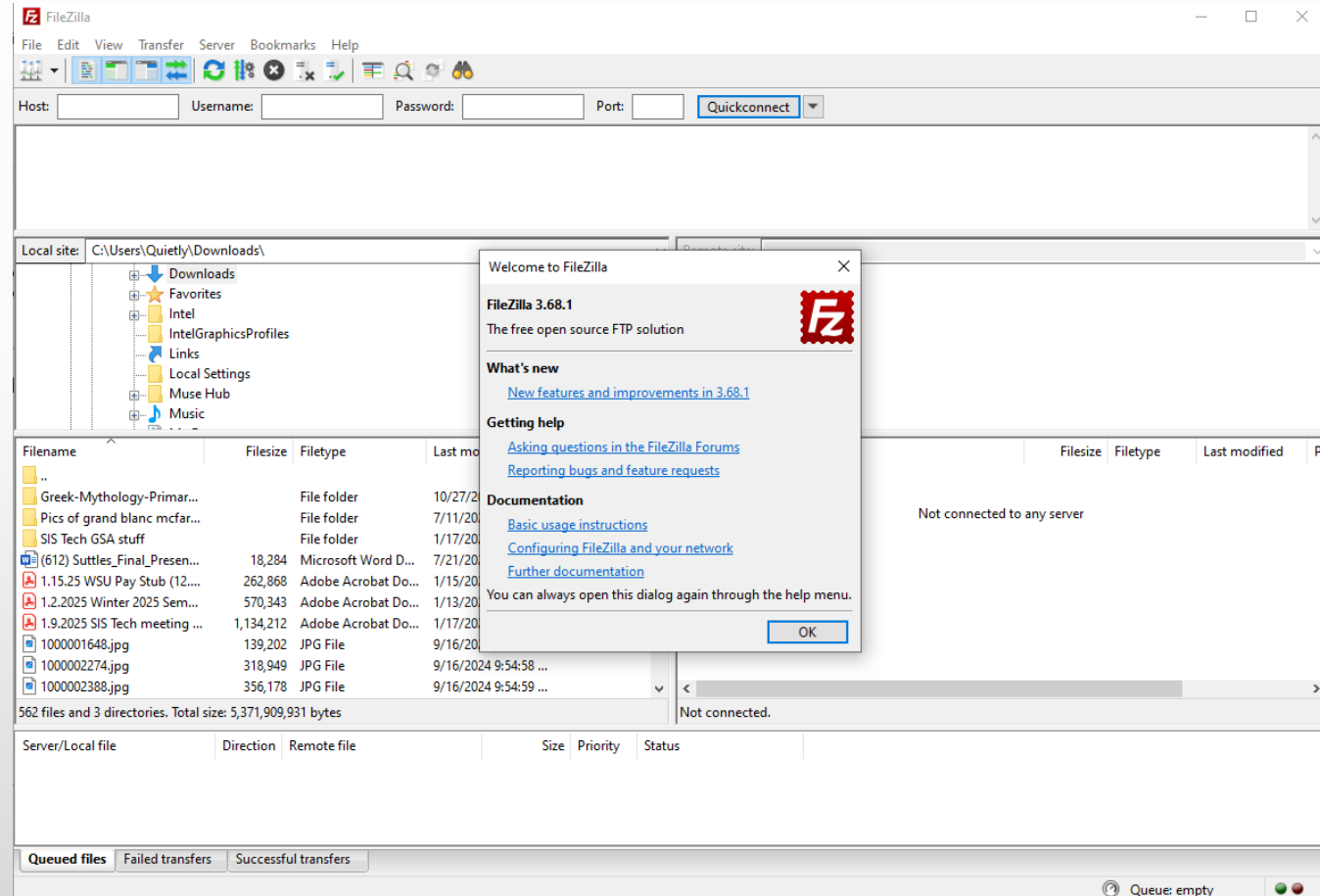
NOTE: If you do not want FileZilla in your Start Menu, check this box.
